

raise passing rates among the lowest achievers. The program focused on areas of need to help


develop core understanding.

### **Change in Passing Rates** in Grades 6 to 8 (2005)




The percent of passing grades increased from 58% in Grade 8 to 411% in Grade 6. The overall percent of increase was 209%.

#### **Change in Mean Scores Pre-Test to Post-Test**



The mean score for ranged from 21% in grade 8 to 51% in grade 6. The average growth in mean scores are 22% in grade 6, 19% in grade 7 and 15% in grade 8. The percent of increase for grades 6, 7, and 8 combined was 32%.

#### **Change within Non-Passing Group - 64%**



Sixty-four percent of the students who <u>failed</u> the Pre-Test <u>passed</u> the Post-Test.
