## MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MD SUMMER SCHOOL 2005

## The Setting...

Where: District wide summer school in Montgomery County, MD

Who: Over 500 students in grades 6-8
When: 4 weeks or 20 days in summer 2005

Purpose: To use Moving with Math ${ }^{\circledR}$ to raise passing rates among the lowest achievers. The program focused on areas of need to help develop core understanding.

Change in Mean Scores Pre-Test to Post-Test


The mean score for ranged from $21 \%$ in grade 8 to $51 \%$ in grade 6. The average growth in mean scores are $22 \%$ in grade $6,19 \%$ in grade 7 and $15 \%$ in grade 8 . The percent of increase for grades 6,7 , and 8 combined was $32 \%$.

## Change in Passing Rates in Grades 6 to 8 (2005)



The percent of passing grades increased from $58 \%$ in Grade 8 to $411 \%$ in Grade 6.
The overall percent of increase was $209 \%$.

Change within Non-Passing Group - 64\%


Sixty-four percent of the students who failed the Pre-Test passed the Post-Test.
